3. MOTEL NOOITGEDACHT (Motel "Never would have thought") artists' initiative and residency, 1999-2004 in co-operation with A. Marshall

'Motel Nooitgedacht' was the former 100 year-old lighthouse keepershouse, situated right at the mouth of the North Sea Channel. In the period of five years Kaleb de Groot and Adam Marshall organized seven exhibitions and hosted several art-happenings such as cinema, theatre and performances.

This exhibition was the last out of a series held at Motel Nooitgedacht in IJmuiden. During one weekend there was a presentation of sculptures, drawings, site specific installations and performances by amongst others Ad de Jong, Jonas Ohlsson, Teske Clijsen, Yasmijn Karhof, Dieuwke Spaans en groep HAP.

Kaleb de Groot organized the exhibition and made the selection of artists, as well as participating himself.




6. STADT I+II

Kaleb selected the artists, and altered and rearranged all artworks into a new setting, overriding their original form.








8. COMMUTERS, 2006

9. GOEDENDAG/ONE HOT BLUE BALL

part one of triptyque, 2007


9 photo's, several sizes (\pm 90x70 cm)

This is the prologue for the triptyque 'Goedendag/One Hot Blue Ball', in which the hammered shut house that was formerly inhabited by Kaleb de Groot, was engraved with a circle saw the very day before it's demolition.

The daylight shining through the deserted house was documented carefully together with photographer Johannes Schwartz. The reverse image (right) was created after sunset by having an artificial light source, referring to the life that once was there.

The frames are handmade out of the wood from the window paines and roof.

10. GOEDENDAG/ONE HOT BLUE BALL [MASTERPLAN]

performance, 2007 harbour IJmuiden

The 'Masterplan' of the triptyque 'Goedendag/One Hot Blue Ball', in which the material of Kalebs' demolished house is transformed into a sculpture, serving as a three dimensional collage in the form of a ball. (refering to a demolition ball).

During the performance Kaleb chained the ball to a pickup car [creating a huge Goedendag, a medeaval weapon] and set himself inside the ball. Then, the ball was dragged through the harbour town of IJmuiden [above] at moderate speed.


